

Membership of the University Centre

The *University Centre* was founded in 1967 to provide leisure facilities for members of the University of Cambridge. The University pays the membership fees for certain categories of people; this document outlines whether you are eligible to be a member of the Centre or not and, if so, how to apply for membership. CAMcard holders: Alumni

Alumni of the University of Cambridge are automatically eligible for membership of the Centre. If asked for proof of membership you should show your *CAMCard* (or your Life Membership card issued by the Cambridge Society, for those to whom this applies). University card holders: Fellows, Staff & Students

Fellows, staff and students of the University have automatic membership. People in these categories should have a University Card with a University Centre logo printed on the back. Retired staff who are members of the USS or CPS pension schemes will receive a membership card granting life membership as part of their retirement pack.
